

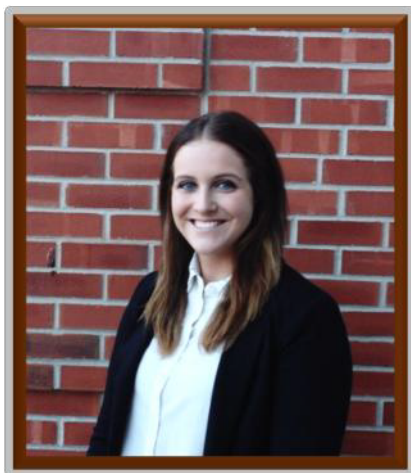

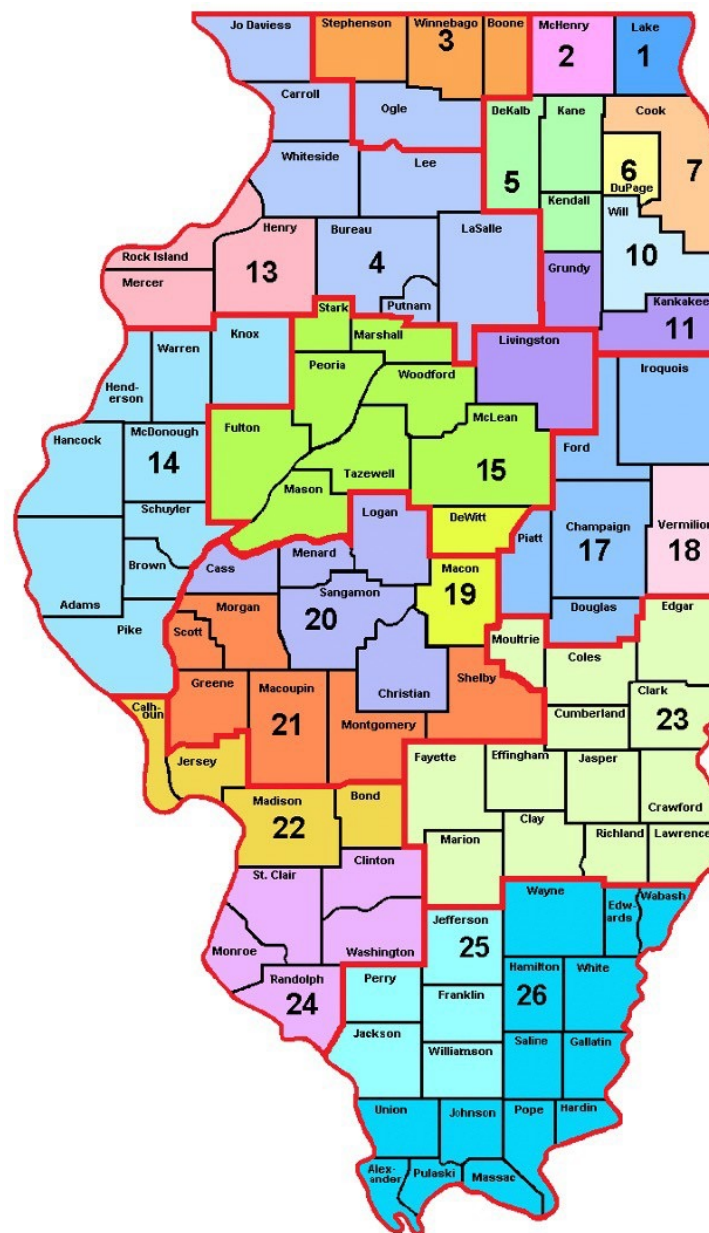

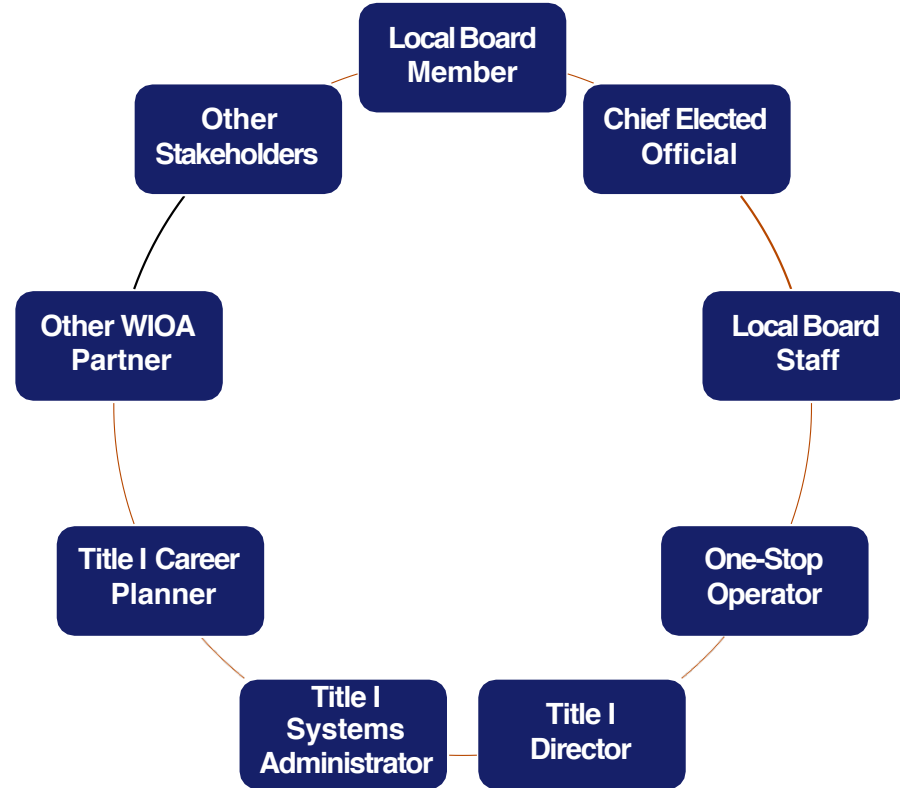

What is ProPath?

ProPath search tool allows users to:

- Search for approved training programs by:
 - Learning Opportunities (Training Programs)
 - Organization (Training Providers)
 - Credentials
- Filter to narrow results by:
 - LWIA or Location
 - Occupations (SOC Code)
 - Instructional Program (CIP Codes)
 - Learning Delivery Types, and much more
- Find programs using map view
- View High level information without going into details (i.e., costs, time, learning method, etc.)
- View details for program/provider information
- Compare programs using the comparison tool

ProPath is powered by the Credential Finder/Credential Registry which allows for expanding the use of program, credential, and outcome related data in future developments.

Why use ProPath framework?

- Identify critical information gaps systematically
- Assist in the development of the IEP/ISS using assessment results (interests, suitability for career/training, etc.) to ensure that employment goals are part of career pathways, setting goals and objectives, etc.
- Address limitations in available information and data for postsecondary education and workforce training opportunities
- Provide more up-to-date (“real time”) information from training providers and for training programs
- Implement administrative data system improvements and understanding of program outcomes¹
- Capture information most appropriate to educational and career pathway decision-making
- Address USDOL monitoring findings related to a statewide ETPL list, highlight various methods of instruction by providers, and improved access to support improved consumer choice to training provider and training program information.

¹ Future updates will address program outcomes as agency partners continue to develop methodology to capture necessary and appropriate outcome data and information


